Reading & Phonics - Please read with your child every day and also listen to them read for at least 10 minutes each evening. Help them to sound out (segment) and blend words that they don't know. It is important to take good care of the books and make sure they are returned to the class as soon as your child has finished reading them. Lost or damaged books will incur a £5 charge.
