SCHOOL LEARNING

Literacy: Narrative writing, Poetry and Non-Fiction

PE days – Year 1 have PE on Mondays and Wednesdays. On these days, children need to come to school wearing their PE kit, with their school uniform and shoes in a bag.

PE uniform: Blue or black shorts or track suit bottoms, with a white T-shirt and plimsolls or black trainers. Please ensure that all clothes including bags have your child's name on it.

HOME LEARNING

Maths: Home learning will be set on www.mathletics.co.uk every week, and as your child completes it, they will be awarded certificates. If you do not have access to the internet at home, we can make sure that your child has access to an iPad during lunch time so that they can complete the work that is set.

Reading: Your child will bring home a selection of books to read and discuss with you. If they are to make the progress needed, they should be reading for at least 15 minutes every day. Please encourage them to change their books regularly and comment and sign their Reading Log. We will also allocate online books at the right level for them on Bug Club which you can access via www.activelearnprimary.co.uk using the log in details we have given you.

Spelling: Spellings will be sent home on Fridays and then tested on the following Friday. Please practise these with your child.

We will also be sending home, learning tasks that are more open-ended which will allow your child to demonstrate their creativity. These will be stuck into their **Home Learning Logs** every other Friday and your child will have 10 days to complete the work. Logs must be handed in the following Wednesday. Again, please make sure your child does the homework and hands it in on time.
