PSHE: New beginnings, Getting on and falling out

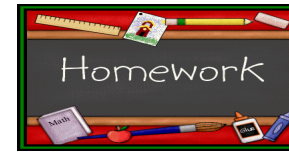
PE: Creative dance

HOME LEARNING



Maths: Home learning will be set on www.mathletics.co.uk every week, and as your child completes it, they will be awarded certificates. If you do not have access to the internet at home, we can make sure that your child has access to an iPad during lunch time so that they can complete the work set then!

Reading: Your child will bring home a selection of books to read and discuss with you. If they are to make the progress needed, they should be reading for at least 15 minutes every day. Please encourage them to change their books regularly. Books have been allocated on Bug Club which you can access via www.activelearnprimary.co.uk using the log in details that are given on their login cards.

We will also send home, some learning tasks that are more open-ended which will allow your child to demonstrate their creativity. These will be stuck into their **Home Learning Logs** every other Friday and your child will have 10 days to complete the work. Logs must be handed in by the Wednesday. Again, please make sure your child does this and hands it in on time.
