### Spelling


In contractions, 2 words are squashed into 1 and there is an apostrophe to show where there are missing letters.

## Monday: Chapter 7 – Lord Spittleworth Tells Tales

In Chapter 7, Lord Spittleworth tries to get the children in trouble so that they won't be allowed to play in the courtyard any more, and King Fred finds out that Daisy Dovetail has called him selfish, vain and cruel.

**Drawing activity:** Draw Daisy Dovetail and write down what she said in a speech bubble.



**Writing task:** If someone is **selfish**, what does that mean? What does the word **vain** mean?

## Tuesday: Chapter 8 – The Day of Petition

For one day every year, the people of Cornucopia can come and meet King Fred and ask him for a special favour. This year, Fred decides he won't be vain and selfish so he dresses in a plain suit and listens carefully to everything that his people ask him.

**Drawing activity:** Design the medal that King Fred gave to Bert Beamish.

## Wednesday: Chapter 9 – The Shepherd's Story

In this chapter, the Shepherd asks King Fred for help and to the surprise of Lord Flapoon and Spittleworth, the King agrees to help him.

**Writing Task:** What did the shepherd say had happened to his dog Patch?



## Thursday: Chapter 10 – King Fred's Quest

In this chapter, the king sets off for the Marshland with all his soldiers.

**Drawing activity:** Draw Lady Elsanda on her balcony as she watches the King and all the soldiers ride their horses out of the Palace and head off to look for the Ickabog.

**Writing task:** Do you think there really is an Ickabog? Why / Why not?

## Friday: Chapter 11– The Journey North

It took 4 days for the King and his men to reach the Marshlands and they had to stop in different places every night.

**Drawing activity:** Choose one of the places that the King stayed the night in, and draw the delicious dinner he had there!

**Writing task:** The chapter ends with everyone arriving at the Marshlands. It sounds very wild and lonely, and then a fog starts to come down so that no one can see anything.

What do you think is going to happen next? Remember to start with... I predict that...





## Maths


